

Mystery Challenge

Measurements:

- Base card -10.5cm x 29.7cm OR 4 ¼" x 11"
- Layer 1 Cardstock- 9.8cm x 14.1cm OR 4 "x 5 1/4"
- Layer 2 Cardstock- 9cm x 9.8cm OR 3 ½" x 4"
- DSP/Cardstocks- Die-cutcircles or Square -1'or2.5cm Take 5 different colours . Die-cut 25 mini circles/Square use scraps if you can! Make sure to have max 5 circles in the same colour family/DSP Patterns
- Speciality Paper 1.2cm x 9.8cm OR ½ "x 4"
- Basic White 10cm x 14.3cm OR 4"x 5¼"
- Twine or ribbon of your choice
- Embellishments of your choice



- Score the Base card at 14.8cm or 5 1/2"
- Emboss the Layer 1 Cardstock, use any embossing folder of your choice



- Attach this Layer 1 to the Base card using Stampin' Dimensional.
- Pick the Layer 2 cardstock.



- Start from the bottom side of the Layer 2 cardstock.
- SET 1: Glue the 5 die-cut circles or squares of the same colour close together.
- Have a Grid Paper that will be helpful to keep it straight



- SET 2: Glue the next set of 5 circles (in the same colours) in between the first row of circles.
- Each circle should slightly overlap the ones in the first row. Like a layering above the circle.
- The excess circles on the sides of the cardstock can be trimmerd off!



- SET 3: Now add the next 4 circles inbetwen to each circles again using glue.
- SET 4: Now again add the next 5 set of circles,
- SET 5: Finally complete the another set of 4 circles.



 Totally you completed 5 sets of circle overlapping like a beautiful layer one on another.



- Now trim the excess added circles from the top using paper snips
- Then adhere the Specailty paper as a border on the top using glue.



- Next, add this Layer 2 piece to the Layer 1 using glue.
- Decorate the front of the card using die-cut pieces, and add the sentiment.



 Finally add Embellishments and ribbon of your choice.
